THE PTL®

The PTL® is an unassisted, self-supported mid- and high-altitude mountain race of 300km with 25,000m of elevation gain, that must be completed within 151:00 hours by a team of 2 or 3 people.

The course is unmarked and includes difficult and risky technical sections such as steep slopes, off-trail navigation, rockfalls and snow-fields. Participants must master the necessary techniques (use of equipment and personal protective equipment) for facing these challenges and be familiar with orienteering methods. Runners must be prepared for difficult natural conditions (cold, heat, fog, rain, etc.), sleep deprivation, nutritional issues, and must ensure team solidarity and helping others when needed.

COMMUNICATION

Being able to communicate with the organization during the race (Race HQ, volunteers on the course, rescuers, etc.) is essential to ensure participant safety.

Therefore, it is mandatory that at least two team members are proficient in either French, English, or Italian (the official languages of the organization). A good level of communication and understanding, including by phone, is required and will be checked during the race bib collection.

By registering for the PTL® participants commit to respecting the environment and the natural areas they cross during the event. Specifically:

- It is strictly forbidden to leave any waste (gel tubes, paper, organic waste, plastic packaging, etc.) on the course
- All participants must retain their waste and packaging until they can dispose of it in the designated trash bins at checkpoints or the villages on the route. The organization encourages runners to carry a waste pouch for this purpose. Disposable cutlery, cups, and bowls will not be provided at checkpoints. This is to reduce plastic consumption by runners and volunteers. You are encouraged to bring your own utensils if you wish to eat hot meals at the checkpoints.
