Each programme is led by experienced mountain leaders, who will adapt the itinerary and timing to the progress of the race and on-the-ground conditions. They will also share their knowledge of the local area, mountain culture and the UTMB® experience. Some are trail runners themselves and have taken part in the UTMB®.

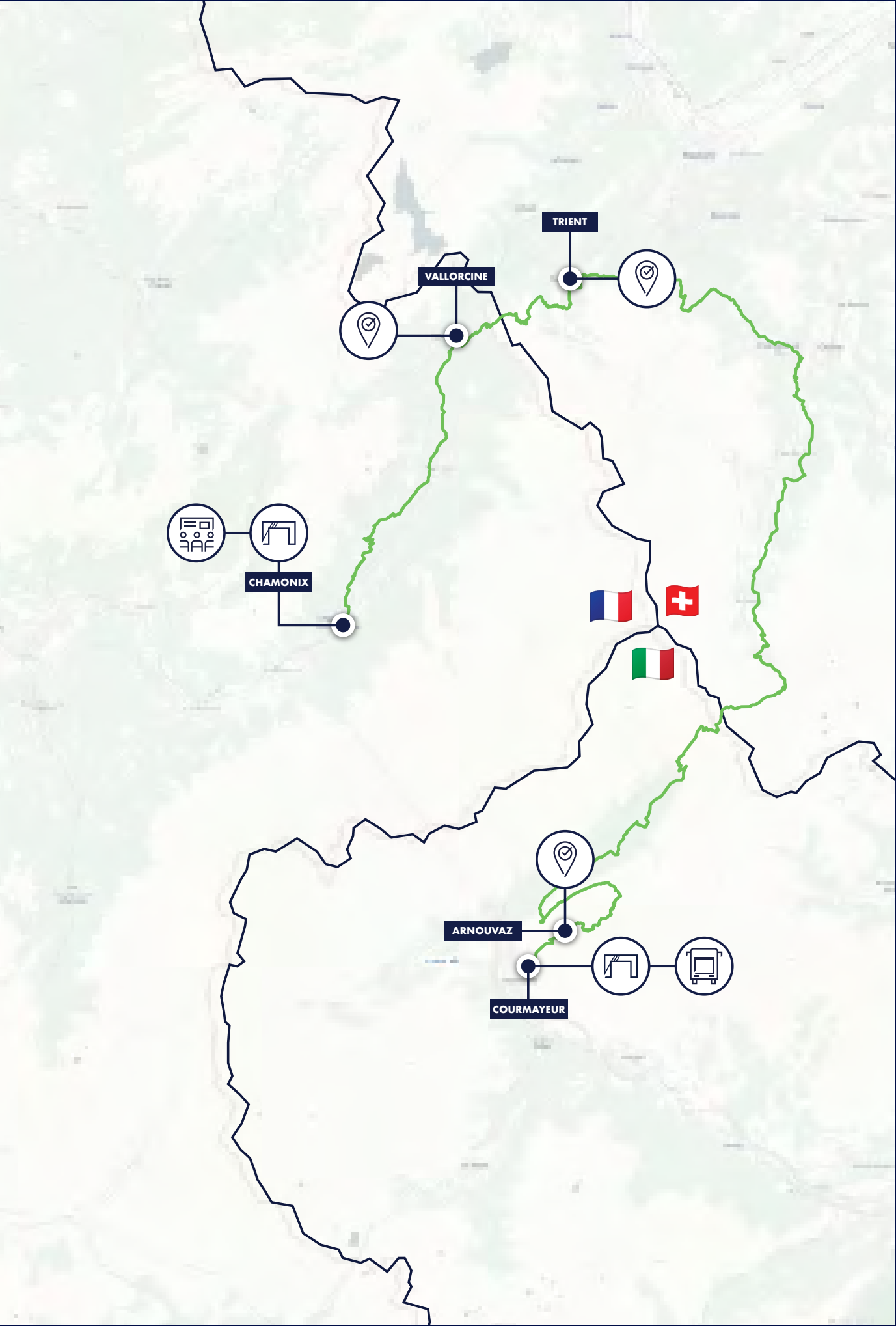

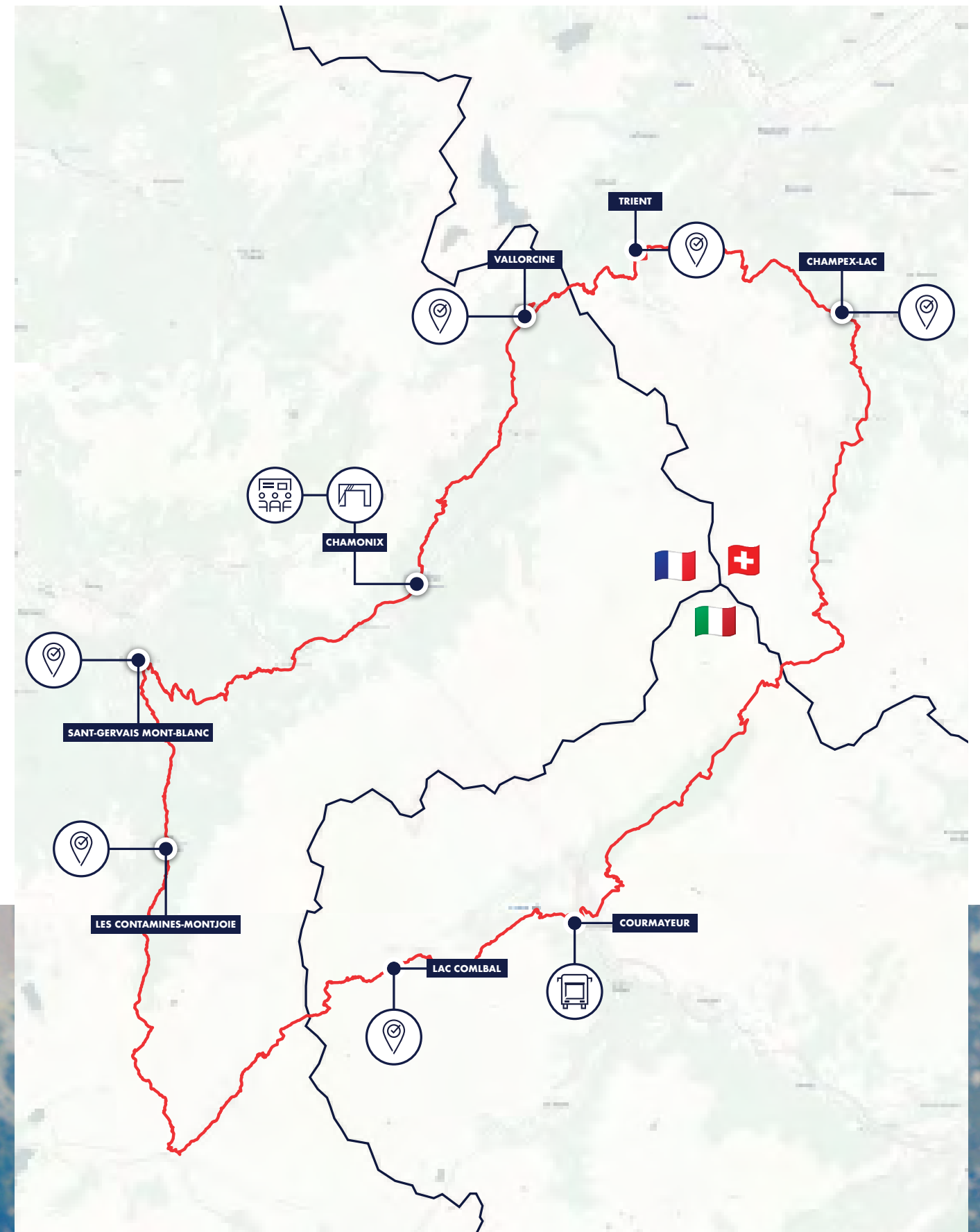

 - **option b)** a mixed shuttle and hiking programme. Ascent to the Bovine alpine pastures, offering breathtaking views.

UTMB® LIGHT EXPERIENCE

This programme offers a combination of sporting coverage and scenic experiences. On Friday, follow the race leaders on the French side of the course. After a rest period, head to Italy for a sunrise hike offering the opportunity to capture outstanding images. Rejoin the race leaders at Vallorcine aid station before returning to Cha-

monix to witness the first finishers. The Light Experience programme is particularly recommended for photo, video and digital media. Passage times are indicative only. Your guide will adapt the schedule according to the actual progress of the race.
